

# JAI ALAI

This exciting game was created more than 400 years ago in Northern Spain. Today, it is played with a curved basket (known as a "cesta") and a ball (called a "pelota"), with players taking turns using their cesta to launch the pelota at a wall for the other player to receive. While the rules are similar to racquetball, the pelota is a much harder ball and has been known to reach speeds of over 200 mph, making it easy to see why this game is known as the "fastest moving ball sport in the world."



Make a splash at **Wekiva Island** and **Wekiwa Springs State Park** with excellent water access and swimming areas or hike through the **Spring Hammock Preserve** with more than 1,500 acres of breathtaking wilderness. With boardwalks that wind through wetlands, pavilions and grills, rentals for canoes, kayaks, playgrounds and courts for every sport, Seminole County parks offer a multitude of experiences the whole family will love.


